On the vaudeville stage, cards and currency were pulled out of thin air and, at the banquet; a cloth table napkin was cut and restored. Finally a flower was magically produced from the napkin. He then demonstrated how he incorporated this knowledge into his rope act by performing a similar amazing routine to music. Quite a mysterious show by Arno.



Founder of Famed Magic Show Le Grand David Dies

Cesareo Pelaez, the charismatic Cuban who escaped his native country and created the world's longest-running stage magic show in Beverly Massachusetts Theater, died Saturday March 24 of congestive heart failure. He was 79. Pelaez suffered a stroke in 2005 and stopped performing his role of Marco the Magi in 2006. Since then, he would appear on stage at the end of each performance of Le Grand David and His Own Spectacular Company in his wheelchair. acknowledging the cheers with a wave of his hands. He made his last appearance Feb. 18 for the company's 35th anniversary show. Over the years, the show drew national and international attention. The troupe performed at the White House seven times. Pelaez was named Magician of the Year by the Academy of Magic Arts Hollywood.

Harry Levy the owner of Hank Lee's Magic Factory in Medford MA has agreed to plead guilty to making over 3500,000 in unauthorized transactions on a customer's credit

card. The credit card charge carries up to a 15 year sentence and the false statements charge 5 years, but the plea agreement said prosecutors will be seeking the "low end" of sentencing guidelines. The agreement also calls for Levy to pay restitution. The case was assigned to Judge Nathan Gorton. "I will remove myself from the everyday activities at Hank Lee's Magic Factory." Since the plea bargain negotiated by Lee might carry time in prison, this may have been necessary at some point.
